The Blackburn Room has the capability of seating 80 persons lecture style, or 60 persons seated around tables.

The Blackburn Room contains numerous features, including:

- a modern audio/video system with:
 - two HD1080 digital video projectors with motorized screens
 - an in-ceiling speaker system
 - confidence monitor
 - a wired lectern microphone
 - wireless hand or lapel microphone options
 - assisted hearing receivers
 - a Crestron automation system designed for easy use
- lectern or table relocatable at front or rear of room
- support for laptop AV connections at lectern, table, and Crestron control panel
- standard AV cables for connecting laptops
- built-in room PC running Windows 10, with applications that include:
 - Microsoft Office 365,
 - LibreOffice,
 - Microsoft Teams,
 - Zoom client,
 - Google Chrome,
 - Microsoft Edge,
 - Mozilla Firefox,
 - Acrobat Reader,
 - Windows Media Player,
 - VLC, and
 - numerous other applications
- adjustable, zoned lighting with presets
- easily moved and stacked tables and chairs for a variety of scenarios
